Draft doc. for discussion with Minister (tx. Siobhán).

Met with PER and Finance this pm and they have concerns around the expectation that we are potentially creating versus the quantum of affordable housing we will be able to provide and the viability of cost rental on State lands.

They also have concerns around elements of the 2009 Act being commenced:

- Reference to State grants, and, If they mean S81 Open Market Dwellings, (in effect a "help to buy" scheme),
 we won't be commencing that. We always said that this would only be commenced if/when market
 conditions would justify it, and that the introduction of this component would be subject of future
 Government consideration before the provisions are commenced.
- 2. The fund (may have GGB issues associated). Don't think this came up before.

I agreed to send them the paper when completed and that we'd clear commencement of the 2009 Act with them before commencement.
